Tee Times

- Tee times <u>must</u> be pre-booked online or via the Pro Shop.
 Under no circumstances should you arrive at the club without booking in advance.
- Online booking is available from 4 days prior at 08:01.
- All play must start from the 1st tee.
- Tee times will be available to book from 0530-2000 each day.
 - IMPORTANT: Greens staff have right of way at ALL times.
- Due to expected demand, only one tee time per person, per day, may be booked.
- Maximum of 2 golfers per tee time with no member's guests or visitors.
- Names of all golfers to be provided at the time of booking.
- The two players may be from different households.
- Initially, there will be no strokeplay or stableford competitions.
- No-shows will be monitored daily and may result in removal of tee booking privileges.

Arrival at the Golf Club

- Travel to the golf course from your home must be in line with Scottish Government guidelines.
- If you are ill, have any symptoms of COVID-19, or are in the highest risk (shielding) group, then stay at home.
- Players should arrive no more than 10 minutes before their booked tee time.
- Park your car in such a way as to facilitate physical distancing.
- Shoes should be changed in the car park before heading to the first tee.
- If you arrive early, please remain in your car until 10 minutes before your start time.
- Ensure you have enough golf balls, tees, etc. You should not exchange any golf equipment with other members.

Clubhouse & Locker Room

- The clubhouse will remain closed until further notice.
- Members should make an appointment via the Managing Secretary to collect golf clubs from their lockers. No access will be available at other times.
- The same applies to personal buggies or trolleys stored at the golf club. You may make an appointment to collect them, but there will not be an option to re-store them.
- Toilet facilties will NOT be available.

Golf Course

- Players must not touch the hole cup or flagstick for any reason.
- Ball retrieval aids will be attached to the pins. Simply lift the metal pin with your putter and your ball will be lifted from the hole back onto the putting surface.
- Players should not touch any equipment or golf balls belonging to others.
- Players must only search for their own ball. If in doubt, play a provisional ball. Returning to where you played your last shot is not allowed.
- Following play of a hole, do not enter the next teeing area until all members of the group in front have played their tee shots and exited the teeing area.
- All course furniture (rakes, ball washers, bins, seats) will be removed or covered up.
- The compressed air machine will be switched off.
- All practice areas and the practice putting green will be closed until further notice.
- Golfers must observe social distancing (2 metres apart) at ALL times on the golf course.
- Players must not join up with other groups while on the golf course.
- Ensure divots are replaced, pitchmarks are repaired and bunker sand is smoothed over.
- The on-course toilet will NOT be available.
- Golfers should leave the golf club area as soon as their round is finished to avoid gatherings which may break social distancing guidelines.
- As members of the public have been using the course during lockdown, please check there is no-one walking across the course before playing, especially on blind shots.
- Do not share equipment, food or drink with other players during your round.
- Please take your litter home, it may be a danger to others.

Pro Shop

- The Pro Shop will be open from 0800-1900 during the summer months.
- Restricted to one golfer in the shop at any one time.
- Pro Shop staff will pick up and hand over goods requested from the shop (e.g snacks and drinks, tees, scorecards, accessories).
- Golfers will not be allowed to browse within the shop and should not touch any products for fear of cross contamination.
- Coaching and fitting will still be available on a one-to-one basis with social distancing being observed. Demo clubs can be taken out if pre-arranged with the Pro.
- No trolleys will be available for hire during the initial period.
- Buggies will only be hired out to members with a valid medical certificate.
- Defined queuing area outside of shop to ensure social distancing.
- Payment should be made by card or on Pro Shop account. <u>Cash will not be accepted</u>. You may call the Pro Shop ahead of your game to top-up your account funds.
