## Etiquette & Courtesy on course

### 1. *Consideration for Other Players*

- No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
- If you are holding up people behind then let them play through (even single players). Wait for them to play/tee off. Allow them to go to their next shot before you continue.
- In the interest of all, players should play without delay.
- No player should play until the players in front are out of range. Players searching for a ball should signal the players behind them to pass as soon as becomes apparent that the ball will not be easily found. They should only search for three minutes. They should not continue play until the players following them have passed and are out of range.
- When the play of a hole has been completed, players should immediately leave the putting green. Enter your score on card at the tee.
- Shout FORE if your or your partners ball is heading towards other players – be extra cautious about this.
- Trolleys should not be left on the tee, green or fringe of green. Leave your bag or trolley at the closest point of access from the green.
- Always rake a bunker after you have been in it.
- Replace any divots (clods of grass) taken out with your shot.
- Repair any pitch marks on greens with a repair tool.

### 2. *Mobile Telephones*

- Mobile telephones should be on silent mode.

## Etiquette & Courtesy on course (contd)

### 3. *Priority on the Course*

- Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round.
- If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the match following to pass.

### COMPETITION TYPES

- ❖ **Match Play** – consists of one side against another over a *stipulated round* unless otherwise decreed by the *Committee*. The game is played by holes.
- ❖ **Stroke or Medal Play** – consists of individual *competitors* playing a *stipulated round* or rounds under rules determined by the *Committee*. In a Scratch competition the winner is the player returning the lowest number of strokes. In a Handicap competition the winner is the player returning the lowest number of strokes less his/her playing handicap.

**SLOW PLAY** can be frustrating for others on the course as well as being avoidable. Maintain a comfortable pace and everybody will benefit.
